Dear Veterinarian,

The Humane Animal Rescue Team, Inc. (H.A.R.T.) is a non-profit organization that has served the animals of the Dallas, Fort Worth and East Texas since 1995. We rescue animals from municipal shelters, take care of their medical needs, including spaying and neutering, and place them in foster home care until permanent homes can be found. We have mobile Adopt-A-Pet events each weekend in various places and we expect to place nearly 300 animals this year. As we continue to grow, we continue to seek veterinarians who would be interested in working with us. Your clinic has been recommended to us.

The adoption donation received from the adopter subsidizes the cost of basic veterinary services, including sterilization, rabies, and testing procedures, as well as initial vaccinations. The adopter is given a copy of the medical information providing for a free health exam; and, occasionally, for vaccinations that are due immediately. An appointment is needed for this free health exam. We are asking veterinarians to assist in our animal rescue efforts by giving the new pets a health examination at no charge to us or to the client. If the animal requires treatment other than that authorized for payment by H.A.R.T., it is the new owner's responsibility to have it treated at their expense at your regular fee for services. We do all we can to insure that adopted pets are healthy, but we are not professionals and cannot always make an accurate analysis of the animal's health. Since most of our pets have been strays and/or have spent time in a municipal shelter - exposure to various infectious diseases is always a possibility.

More details about the services we provide, with a schedule of fees we can afford to pay, are shown on the attached page. This is the full price and the owner should not be required to pay additional charges for these procedures. You should bill us for the services that were authorized. We recognize that we are asking for service at a considerable discount. Please consider that many of our adopters are new pet owners looking for a vet in their area. We believe our referrals will certainly bring you new clients.
